The Tribunal

Having seen the claim filed by applicant on the 2nd February 2017, whereby he claimed the amount of €395.00 paid to defendant for tickets to a boxing event, which event was cancelled and no refund offered.

Having seen that the defendant was duly notified. (see email dated 17 May 2017).

Having heard the plaintiff on oath.

Having seen that the defendant never appeared for the sittings nor presented a reply.

Considers

That according to plaintiff, seven tickets were purchased for a boxing event that was due to take place on the 30th September 2016 at the Hilton Hotel. The event was subsequently cancelled three days before - on the 27th September. Despite repeated requests by plaintiff, no refund was ever forthcoming.

The Tribunal finds no reason to doubt the veracity of plaintiff's version, all the more when defendant did not bother to contest the case or make an appearance at any of the sittings.

Tribunal therefore upholds the claim and condemns defendant to refund plaintiff the sum of €395.00 for the reasons above mentioned.

Costs are to be borne by defendant.
