Vs

Ian Gauci and Chris Gauci exercising business as Signature Doors/Bertolotto

Today *St* of March, 2015.

The Tribunal,

Took cognizance of the request by Juergen and Akram Krekeler filed on the 22nd of Coctober, 2014 whilst Ian Gauci and Chris Gauci exercising business as Signature Doors/Bertolotto, although duly notified, failed to file a reply and to appear in front of this Tribunal;

Examined the presented documents, heard plaintiff and the verbal submissions made on the 15th of January, 2015;

Considered

That this case is about an order of works regarding doors that even when put in place (a long time after the promised date) had a lot of damages as shown in the presented photos;

That Ian Gauci and Chris Gauci exercising business as Signature Doors/Bertolotto failed to reply to plaintiff's request and also failed to appear during the sitting in front of this Tribunal to contest plaintiff's arguments;

That this Tribunal has only plaintiff's version which was not contested in any way by defendants;

That defendants' failure to appear, does not mean that this Tribunal refrains from examining plaintiff's request and whether this is justified;

That plaintiff explained his request as outlined in his claim and presented copies of invoices and other documentation to confirm such claim;

That on the other hand, defendants failed to appear to contest plaintiff's claim and give their version of events;

Consequently for the abovementioned reasons and in the circumstances of this case and after examining Chapter 378 of the Laws of Malta, this Tribunal Decides to Accede to the claim made by Juergen and Akram Krekeler and Orders Ian Gauci and Chris Gauci exercising business as Signature Doors/Bertolotto to pay Juergen and Akram Krekeler the sum of €2000 as confirmed by the presented documentation. The expenses of these procedures are to be paid as well by Ian Gauci and Chris Gauci exercising business as Signature Doors/Bertolotto.
