<b>Producers (Category 'A')</b>	
Annual certification fee for a total area of up to 1 tumolo	€150
Per additional tumolo	€65
Up to a maximum annual certification fee	€540
<b>Processors (Category 'B')</b>	
Annual certification fee	€120
<b>Importers (Category 'C')</b>	
Annual certification fee	€800
<b>Retailers (Category 'D')</b>	
Annual certification fee	€120
<b>Wholesaler (Category 'E')</b>	
Annual certification fee	€300
<b>Other Traders (Category 'F') (e.g. Warehousing, Transportation, NEC activities)</b>	
Annual certification fee	€300

**Notes:**

1. All prices are inclusive of VAT.
2. Operators who apply for more than 1 category are to pay a total annual fee for all categories applied for.
3. To start the certification process, the operator shall fill in the application from SMIC-(ORG) F01
4. Once the service agreement has been signed and the certification process has start all fees are non-refundable. (Refer to the terms and conditions in the service agreement)
5. All fees are non-refundable is certification is unsuccessful and non-compliances with applicable organic farming regulations are identified and not addressed.
6. MCCAA may ask operators for additional testing<sup>1</sup> fees.
