Mark Cilia La Corte
Vs
Portelli & Brincat Ltd

Today 28th of July, 2022.

The Tribunal,

Took cognizance of the request by Mark Cilia La Corte filed on the 11th of February, 2022 whilst Portelli & Brincat Ltd, although duly notified, failed to file a reply and to appear in front of this Tribunal;

Examined the presented documents, heard plaintiff and the verbal submissions made on the 28th of June, 2022;

Considered

That this case is about an order of blinds which when delivered, were allegedly different from those ordered. According to plaintiff, both the material and the mechanisms were different from those as ordered;

That Portelli & Brincat Ltd failed to reply to plaintiff's request and also failed to appear during the sitting in front of this Tribunal to contest plaintiff's arguments;

That this Tribunal has only plaintiff's version which was not contested in any way by defendant company;

That defendant company's failure to appear, does not mean that this Tribunal refrains from examining plaintiff's request and whether this is justified;

That plaintiff explained his request as outlined in his claim and presented documentation to confirm such claim;

That on the other hand, defendant company failed to appear to contest plaintiff's claim and give their version of events;

Consequently for the abovementioned reasons and in the circumstances of this case and after examining Chapter 378 of the Laws of Malta, this Tribunal Decides to Accede to the claim made by Mark Cilia La Corte and Orders Portelli & Brincat Ltd to pay Mark Cilia La Corte the sum of €1900 as confirmed by the presented documentation. The expenses of these procedures are to be paid as well by Portelli & Brincat Ltd.
