

**PUBLIC NOTICE ISSUED BY THE DIRECTOR GENERAL (CONSUMER AFFAIRS) WITHIN
THE MALTA COMPETITION AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS AUTHORITY**

March 2026

The Director General (Consumer Affairs), in terms of Article 8 of the Consumer Affairs Act (Cap. 378), is issuing this Public Notice by which she is identifying and informing the public that the following trader:

Colin Pavia

operator of Colshar Garage, Fgura, failed to honour six decisions delivered by the Consumer Claims Tribunal, notwithstanding several attempts made to secure compliance therewith. All of the said decisions relate to school transport services which the trader failed to provide.

In the **first decision**, the trader was ordered to reimburse the consumer the sum of **two hundred and twenty-five euro (€225)** (CCT 51/25).

In the **second decision**, the trader was ordered to pay the sum of **two hundred and fifty euro (€250)** (CCT 42/25).

In the **third decision**, the trader was ordered to pay the sum of **three hundred euro (€300)** (CCT 43/25).

In the **fourth decision**, the trader was ordered to pay the sum of **five hundred euro (€500)** (CCT 60/25).

In **two other cases**, the trader was ordered to pay the sum of **two hundred euro (€200)** to each of the respective claimants (CCT 61/25 and 50/25).

In all of the above-mentioned decisions, the defendant trader was also ordered to pay the costs of the proceedings.

This Public Notice is being issued in the interest of consumer protection and without prejudice to any other action which may be taken in accordance with the law. This notice does not constitute a decision on any matter other than that established in the aforementioned Tribunal decisions.
