

PUBLIC WARNING STATEMENT ISSUED BY THE DIRECTOR GENERAL (CONSUMER AFFAIRS) WITHIN THE MALTA COMPETITION AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS AUTHORITY

3rd August 2026

The Director General (Consumer Affairs), in terms of Article 8 of the Consumer Affairs Act (Cap. 378), is issuing this Public Statement by which she is identifying and informing the public that the following trader:

Domnic Sciberras

has been the subject of a decision by the Consumer Claims Tribunal, which decision has not been honoured, despite several attempts having been made to secure compliance therewith.

By its decision, the Tribunal ordered Mr Domnic Sciberras to refund the consumers the sum of four thousand two hundred and twenty-one euro (€4,221.00) in relation to works carried out on the rooftop of the consumers' property. The Tribunal further ordered Mr Domnic Sciberras to pay the Tribunal expenses amounting to one hundred and nineteen euro and twenty-two cents (€119.22).

The total amount due by Mr Domnic Sciberras therefore amounts to four thousand three hundred and forty euro and twenty-two cents (€4,340.22).

This Public Statement is being issued in the interest of consumer protection and without prejudice to any other action which may be taken in accordance with the law. This notice does not constitute a decision on any matter other than that established in the above-mentioned Tribunal decision.
